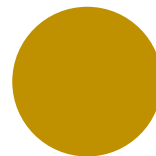

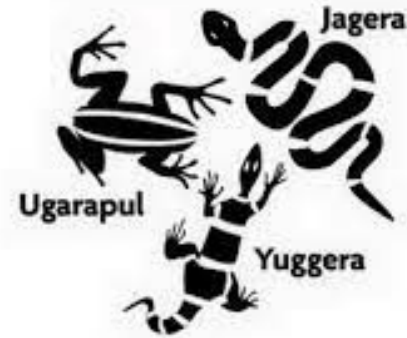

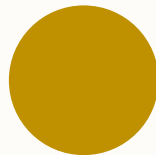


Dear Greater Springfield,

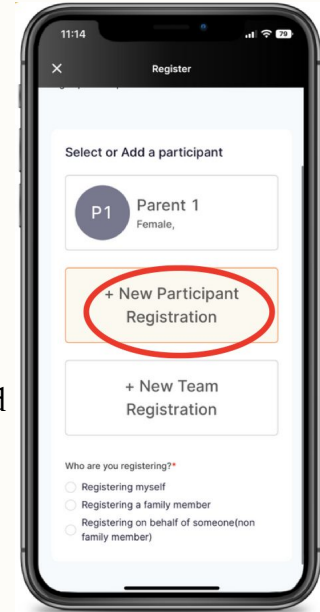


1.1 Registrations

Registration Overview & Process

To register follow these steps:

1. Download Basketball Connect App
2. To follow the GSBA Basketball Connect Guide, please refer to the end of this pack.
3. Fill out the online registration form with accurate information.
4. Complete the payment process using the preferred method.
5. Submit an email to the Club House following registration notifying them your child's name and DOB as you entered into the app
6. All existing players will be automatically assigned to their teams.
7. New players are kindly requested to contact the Club House Leader upon completing their registration. You will then be placed in a team and introduced to your team manager to prepare for the upcoming season.

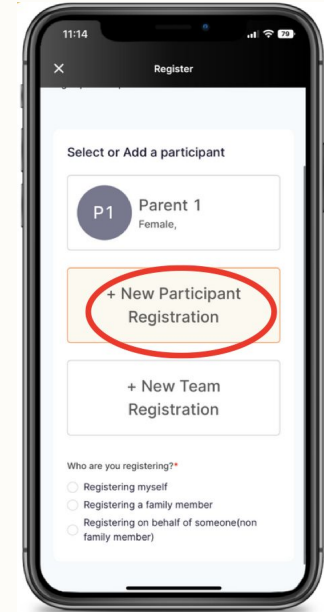

1.2 Eligibility & Rules

Eligibility Criteria

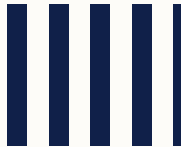
- All players must be registered members to participate and play in Greater Springfield Basketball League
- Participants must meet the age requirements for their respective divisions.
- To be eligible for an age group, players must not turn that age before December 31st of the year
- To qualify for the finals, players need to participate in a minimum of 70 percent of the season's games
- *New players transferring from another association for representative purposes must participate in our competition for a minimum of seven games to be eligible for transfer. GSBA will assist successful candidates*
- Junior players may play in their age group and as a fill in to a higher age group should the team be short with only 4 players :
 - and a) Players cannot play for more than one team in the same division:
 - and b) A maximum of 12 players can be included on each team list for the entire season:
 - and c) A minimum of 7 players must be included on all team lists.
- Players may apply for an exemption to play in a younger or older age category by submitting a their respective club house administrator.



- Parents of Hot Shots U8, U10, and Hoops U12, U14 and Pionettes are required to **score bench** 3-4 times per season for their teams.
- Hot Shots U8 & U10 - games will not start until we have 1 parent from each team
- *Hoops U12 & U14 teams* - **A penalty of 1 point per minute will be given to the opposing team if scoring duties are not fulfilled by the start of the game.**
- **\$10 fee for a score bench to cover your shift is payable on your day rostered**

- **Uniforms** must be ordered at the time of registration to ensure timely delivery. Special exemptions will be granted to players whose uniforms have been delayed.
- Rent a playing singlet for \$10 on game day and return it afterward. This option is available if loan singlets are in stock.
- Wearing an incorrect playing uniform past ordering time will result in a 5-point penalty per garment, awarded to the opposing team.

- In case of **injury**, players may request an exemption for participation by submitting a medical certificate. The medical certificate should specify the date of diagnosis, the injury details, and the clearance date for their return to play. Please note: season fees are non-refundable





- **Team forfeits** must be reported to the association by the Clubhouse Administrator no later than 24 hours before the scheduled game time to ensure the opposing team is notified. The opposing team will be awarded a 20-0 victory on the draw.
- **Senior forfeit fine** of \$100 is payable to the association if a team forfeits within 24 hours of the scheduled game and payable within 12 hours. To avoid the forfeit fine, teams should ensure that fill-ins are arranged with plenty of notice.
- *When you register to play for a Club House Team for a season, you're committing fully to that team, which takes priority over any other club or association teams playing on the same night.*
- If we learn that you've abandoned your club team for another team, resulting in a forfeit due to low player numbers, you will be charged a \$170 forfeit fine, payable within 24 hours. This fine will be refunded to both teams affected by the forfeit.



1.3 Fees & Payment Options

Season Fees

- To facilitate a seamless and uninterrupted basketball season, we kindly ask that you make your payments by the specified installment dates. Automatic payments are conveniently set up through the Basketball Connect app, and deductions are processed via Stripe. Be aware that failed payments may incur additional fees, and we're committed to assisting you in avoiding any inconvenience. Stay on top of your payments by utilising the app's features and take a snapshot of your payment schedule. Your cooperation ensures a hassle-free and enjoyable basketball experience for everyone involved.

- Payment Options: Pay in full or instalments
- **NO REFUNDS** - *Non negotiable*
- Please ensure you are fully financial in our association if you are playing elsewhere. All outstanding balances will be handed over to Basketball QLD. You will be required to pay these balances; otherwise, you will not be permitted to take the court in any other association competition.



Stripe Agreement

By signing up to play, you enter into a binding agreement through Basketball Connect and Stripe. Please note that we cannot cancel direct debits or offer a cash payout plan. You have the option to pay in full or in installments upon registration. If an installment payment fails, you are required to catch up as per your agreement with Stripe. Please ensure your payment details are current and up to date every fortnight. **\$15 Late fee will be charged for follow ups of missed payments**

Refunds for fees are not provided, as outlined when signing up through Basketball Connect. Fees paid cover your commitment for the entire season. Injuries can be claimed through V Insurance via Basketball QLD. If a player withdraws, season fees are still liable to be paid. ***Our charges are based on the entire season, not on a per-game nor per training basis.***

1.4 Fair Play Voucher

Fair Play Voucher Key dates

- 30 May 2025: Round 11 applications close (or earlier if fully allocated)
- 6 June 2025: Round 11 vouchers must be presented to an activity provider

The popular FairPlay program is open to all Queensland children aged from 5 to 17 years from 1 July 2024, with the voucher value increased per child to \$200 to offset the rising cost of junior sport for families.

There is a limit of 1 voucher per child per financial year.

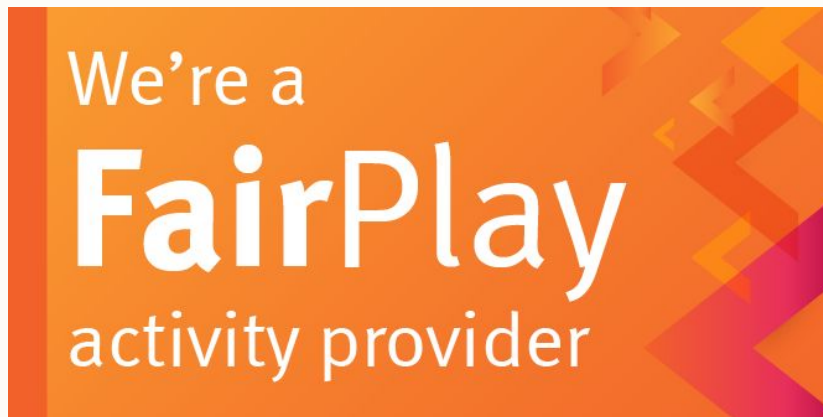

Please note that our installment plan is not available when redeeming your \$200 voucher through the Basketball Connect app during registration. This feature is not supported by the app.



If you wish to use the installment option, please send your Fair Play voucher code to finance@pioneersbasketball.net for redemption. A discount code will be generated and provided to you, with a \$20 fee applicable. This code can be entered at check out and discount will be applied and your installment plan will be accepted

If you receive a Fair Play voucher after completing registration, we will handle the redemption process on your behalf and reimburse you once your season fees are paid in full, with a \$20 fee applicable.

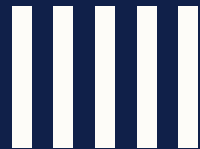

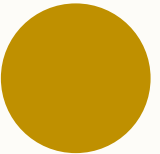



3.9.2 Parent Score Bench Duty - Friday Juniors & Saturdays Hot Shots

- Please be aware that we do not employ score bench duty on Saturdays to keep costs affordable. Instead, we rely on each family to participate in a team roster.
 - *Please be aware parents will be required to participate in voluntary score bench duty for their child's team on a rotational roster*
 - *A \$10 fee is requested for score bench coverage on the day if you choose not to participate.*
 - This fee is a gesture of appreciation for parents or siblings who generously contribute their time, allowing you to watch your child on your rostered day. If you wish to opt out of score bench and choose to pay \$10 per game see the front desk to organise 30 mins before scheduled game time. Additionally, each Club House will offer a scorebench course to help you prepare for the season.

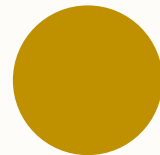


10.1 Volunteer Opportunities

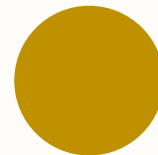

12.1 Warning

WARNING CARD



**BASKETBALL
QUEENSLAND**

You are being issued a warning that the comments, gestures, and/or behaviours that you have directed at the players, coaches, game officials, or other spectators constitute excessive verbal abuse or behaviour that is disruptive or interferes with a game participant or another spectator in violation of the Basketball Queensland Code of Conduct. This is the first and only warning that you will receive. If, after receiving this warning, you continue to verbally abuse any player, coach, game official, or spectator, or engage in behaviour that is disruptive or interferes with a game participant or another spectator, your team will be issued with a tech foul and you will be immediately ejected from the stadium.



12.2 Purpose & Process

Purpose:

Spectator warning cards are implemented in Basketball Queensland to address inappropriate behavior promptly. The visual cue serves as a calm but effective indication, emphasising consequences.

Process:

1. Court controller/Referee Supervisor gives warning card to team manager/personnel for the identified spectator.
2. Team representative issues warning card, signaling potential team penalties and spectator ejection if behavior persists.
3. Persistent misconduct prompts a game halt. A bench technical is issued, and the spectator is immediately ejected, delaying the game until their removal.
4. Repeated warning card instances may result in a competition ban for the spectator and Basketball Qld notified.

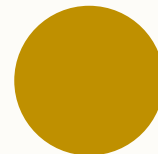
